



ROUTINE CARE AUTHORIZATION

Horses arriving without current coggins, vaccination and deworm dates, will be vaccinated, dewormed and coggins pulled upon arrival.

1. All horses will be dewormed upon arrival unless they have been done within 45 days of arrival or unless they are currently on daily wormer.
2. All horses will be vaccinated for West Nile, Eastern, Western, EVA, Tetanus, Flu, Rhino and Strep unless proof they have been vaccinated within 6 months of arrival is presented to Buffalo Ranch.
3. Buffalo Ranch requires that all horses must be vaccinated against EVA 21 days prior to arrival. If for any reason a horse has not been vaccinated against EVA prior to arrival, Buffalo Ranch will perform an initial EVA vaccination (upon receipt of a negative blood test) and will require at least 21 days of quarantine care before the horse is allowed in general population or to leave the facility.
4. Mares foaled out at Buffalo Ranch will have post-foaling uterine treatment including antibiotics if necessary. Foal will be tested for IcG levels at 12 to 24 hours of age and any foal testing borderline or deficient will receive hyperimmune plasma at the foal owner's expense.
5. Foals will be dewormed every 30 days starting at 30 days old.
6. Feet trimmed on horses every 45-60 days or as needed.
7. Foal vaccinations starting at 6 months of age: Eastern, Western, EVA, Tetanus, Flu, Rhino, West Nile.

THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE ABOVE

The following are routine procedures that may be used:

- Uterine cultures will be performed as deemed necessary by the Veterinarian in charge.
- Medication to enhance the chance of pregnancy may be used:

Post breeding uterine treatment	Prostaglandin to bring mare into heat
HCG or Ovuplant on day bred to hasten ovulation	Regumate to control irregular cycles
Oxytocin to expel uterine fluid	

With the exception of immediate emergency situations (we will make every effort to contact you as soon as possible), the owner will be notified if any treatment appears to be excessively costly or of long duration.

I agree and understand that neither Buffalo Ranch nor its representatives will be responsible for accidents, sickness, death, or acts of God to my horse(s). However Buffalo Ranch and its representatives will use all means of expertise and care to prevent misfortune. I will look solely to my own insurance company in the event of misfortune to my horse(s).

Regular receiving and departure hours for visiting horses are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This will allow staff sufficient time to prepare the required health papers and final statement to settle all accounts.
